AR 360 Non Fiction Articles

Students who have taken an AR STAR test can select high-interest nonfiction articles at their level to read and then take a quiz.

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Click on the **Read an Article** button to see a list of articles at your reading level. You can also search articles by topic. Be sure to check the reading level of the article before reading. There is a short quiz at the end of each article.
