This confirms that you have completed all the steps necessary in Aeries to begin registration for the 2021/2022 school year. **Please print out the emergency card and bring it on your student(s) assigned registration day that will occur starting with Seniors on August 5th, 2021 to finalize your students registration.** Our office will be open beginning August 3rd between the hours of 9:00 am - 3:30pm.

Dear Parent or Guardian:

The following sequence of high school courses is required by the Academic Senate of the University of California as appropriate for fulfilling the minimum eligibility requirements for admission to the University of California. It also illustrates the minimum level of academic preparation students ought to achieve in high school to undertake university-level work.

To satisfy this requirement, students must complete the 15 year-long high school courses listed below. These courses are also known as the "a-g" subjects. At least seven of the 15 year-long courses must be taken in your last two years of high school.

These courses must be certified by the University as meeting the requirement and must be included on your school's UC-certified course list. (For a complete list of UC approved courses for your school, please visit www.ucop.edu/appguide , click on "A-G Course Lists" and search for Northview High School.)

The "a-g" requirements are as follows:

Area	Subject Requirements	Years
a.	U.S. History and Social Science	2
b.	English	4
c.	Mathematics (Algebra 1, Geometry, and Intermediate Algebra)	3
d.	Science with Laboratory (1 year Biological and 1 year physical)	2
e.	Language Other than English (the same language)	2
f.	Visual and Performing Arts (Art, Dance, Theatre/Drama, and Music)	1
g.	An additional year, chosen from the a-f list	1

The California State University system has agreed to accept courses certified by the University of California to meet its subject area requirements.

The California Department of Education (CDE) defines Career Technical Education (CTE) as follows:

Career technical education engages all students in a dynamic and seamless learning experience resulting in their mastery of the career and academic knowledge and skills necessary to become productive, contributing members of society.
