



How to Sign-in if Your Computer Says “Content Keeper Authentication”

Step 1- Click the banner at the bottom of the screen that says “Click here to login with Google”



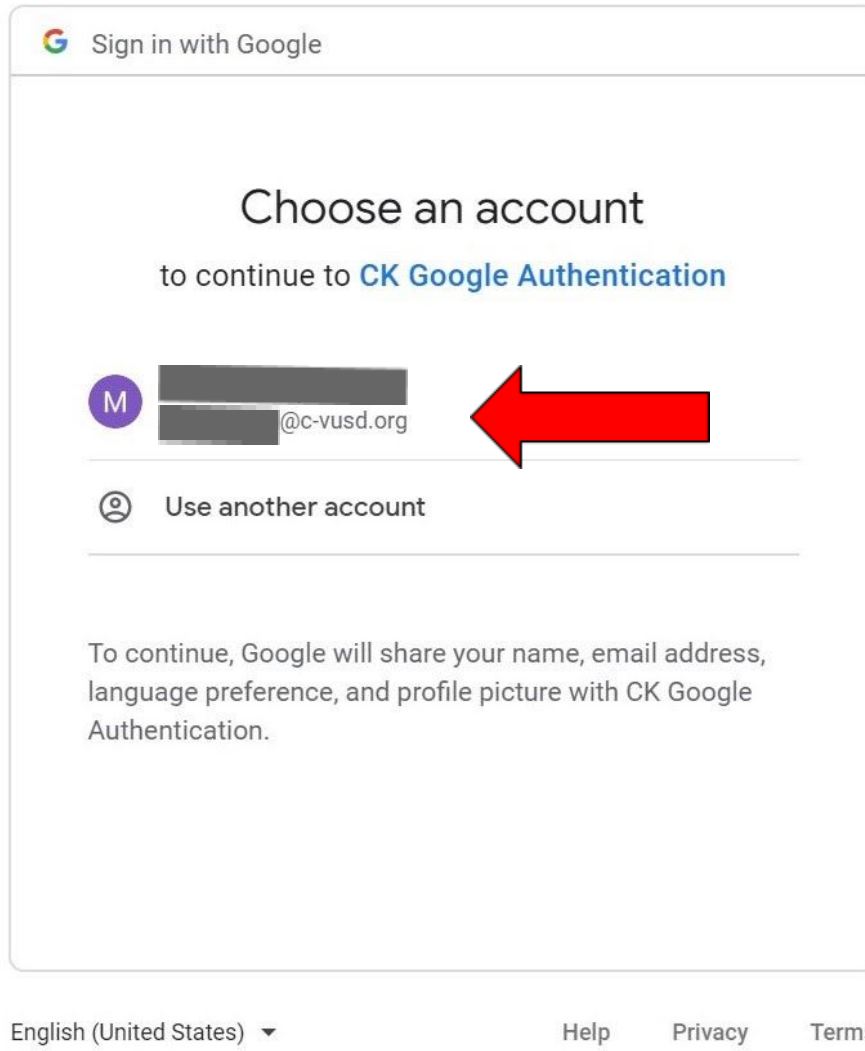
