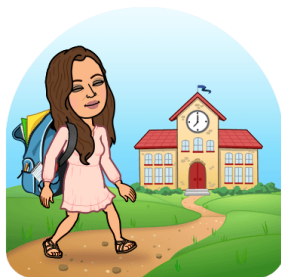

Morning Procedures:

Drop Off	Use the right/valet lane (closest to the curb) OR the middle lane. There is no supervision prior to 7:30am. DO NOT DROP OFF before 7:30am.
7:30am-7:55am	Breakfast (More information here)
7:55am	Gate Opens for all students
8:05am	First Bell. All students are expected to be on campus.

Health & Safety Procedures:

Water Bottles	Please send a refillable water bottle with your child every day. Water filling stations are available throughout the campus.
Food	Please do not send candy, gum, or soda with your child. Food may not be shared among students. We discourage food drop off.
Hand Washing	Hand washing stations with soap are located throughout the campus.
Hand Sanitizer	Sanitizer will be used upon entering the classroom/library and leaving/returning from recess/lunch.
Masks	All adults and children are required to wear masks indoors.
LACDPH	All district and Los Angeles County Department of Public Health guidelines will be adhered to on campus. Updates will be sent by the district and school.

Campus/Classroom Procedures:

- Uniforms are required. The uniform policy may be [found here](#).
- Teachers and instruction are not interrupted during the school day unless there is an emergency.
- Cell phones are not to be used on campus at any time. Cell phones brought on campus must be powered off and kept out of sight in a backpack. Students may only use cell phones after school when calling family.
- We recommend that you send your child to school with a backpack and basic school supplies. Teachers will provide a specific supply wish list for their class.

Pick Up Procedure:

- Students will be seated in lines by grade level/class on the grass area at the front of the campus.
- Students are directed to let the supervising adults know when they see their pick up vehicle or person.
- The right/valet lane (closest to the curb) and the middle lane may both be used for pick up.
- In order to expedite traffic, students will only be released to vehicles once they reach the end of the lane. Please ensure that the adult picking up your child knows their first/last name and grade level.
- For everyone's safety, adults and children must use the crosswalk at the end of the island.
