Halloween is almost here! To make sure everyone can enjoy the festivities safely and appropriately, here are our Halloween dress code guidelines for the day:

- **School-Appropriate Costumes:** Costumes must adhere to the standard dress code. This means no costumes that are overly revealing, and nothing depicting violent, graphic, or offensive themes.
- **No Masks or Full-Face Paint:** For safety, masks that cover the entire face or costumes that obscure your identity, including full-face paint, are not allowed. Hats and small accessories are permitted if they do not disrupt class.
