Covina-Valley Unified’s Maintenance, Operations, Facilities, and Transportation Department Update Facilities, Prepare for Students’ Return

Covina-Valley Unified School District’s Maintenance, Operations, Facilities, and Transportation Department (MOFT) worked hard during the summer break, making upgrades and improvements at sites across the District in preparation for the return of students and the 2023-24 school year.

MOFT completed roofing repairs at Traweek Middle School, Manzanita Elementary, and Northview High School; remodeled the medical career technical education pathway classrooms at our high schools; made cafeteria flooring improvements at Northview and Covina high schools; and ripped out uneven asphalt to install new concrete basketball and volleyball courts at Traweek.

MOFT is also finalized the work on Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning repairs across the District, including replacing old HVAC split systems at numerous elementary sites and installing CO2 sensors in every classroom in the District.

Maintenance staff also swept the campuses throughout the District and inspected every door closer to ensure all doors were correctly closed for safety and security.

“If these door closers are not working right, the door could either slam and potentially hurt someone or not close fully and be insecure,” MOFT Director Keith Kovach said. “Ten minutes of preventative maintenance can go a long way in ensuring the safety of our students.”

In addition to these larger projects, MOFT also completed their routine maintenance work, including the cleaning of gutters, checking area drains, clearing roofs, trimming back trees, filling cracks in asphalt, and more to keep all facilities in top condition in time for the first day of school on Monday, Aug. 21.
